- The school is working on an agreement with Club de Soccer Roussillon to start a soccer program for 24 kids, boys and girls, from grades 4 to 6.
- The school will be providing a staff member (physical education teacher) and the costs of this will be absorbed by tutoring budget.
- The school will also provide equipment (about 1500\$ worth) that will remain in the school.
- The cost to run the program is about 5000\$.
- Will be a “user/payer” program, will cost +/- 250\$ per kid for 60 sessions.
- There will be a try out first to select the 24 kids.
